Dear Parents,

Attached is the pre-registration packet for the 2009-2010 school year. Please take the time over Christmas vacation to review and complete this packet. Return this packet along with the pre-registration fee of \$175 between January 5th and 9th; all placements are based on a first come first served basis. Please note the following changes to our policies that will be in effect as of June 2009:

1. Kindergarten through 8th Grade Uniform Policy has changed for the 2009-2010 school year. Please see information included in this packet.
2. After reviewing the budget needs for the 2009-2010 school year, the following changes will be made. Please see attached fee schedule for the complete list.
 - a. Preschool Part Time tuition will increase beginning June 1, 2009.
 - b. A one time emergency supply fee of \$20 per child will be due March 1, 2009 for all returning students. Emergency packs will not longer be required.
 - c. A yearly Facilities fee of \$75 will be due on September 1st of each year beginning in 2009.
 - d. A yearly Technology fee of \$100 will be due on June 1st of each year beginning in 2009 for all K1-8th grade students.
 - e. The book fee will increase by \$50 and will be due on June 1st of each year beginning in 2009 for all K1-8th grade students. K1-3rd Grade book fee is \$150, 4th-8th Grade book fee is \$200.
3. H.I.S. hours will increase to 25 hours per year per family for the 2009-2010 school year.
4. It will be required for at least one parent to attend the Back to School Night, along with the fall and spring information nights scheduled in September and April by the School Board. Each family in attendance will receive a 1.5 hour per meeting credit, maximum of 5 hours, toward the required H.I.S. hours.
5. Any student K1-8th Grade who arrives to school late will be considered tardy. Upon the 4th tardy, and any tardy thereafter, the parent will be required to either do lunch time yard duty or pay a \$2 per minute late fee.
6. FCS provides accommodation for students with academic, physical, behavioral and emotional challenges. However, when these challenges interfere with the progress of the student and the needs of the class as a whole, parental partnership and outside intervention will be required in order to continue serving the child.
7. All Middle School Students will be required to maintain a 2.0 or higher G.P.A to participate in 8th Grade Graduation Ceremonies.
8. Any FCS student 3rd-8th Grades who falls below a 2.0 G.P.A will be put on academic probation. Any student who maintains a G.P.A of 3.75 or higher will be put on the Honor Roll.
